We steer a lot of families to no cost summer activities, to the **free lunch program** (there's a fabulous site at the **Wallingford Boys & Girls Club**), to our collaborative Reading Buddies program, WIC, Family Advocacy and more.



On an exciting legislative note, we are excited to hear that **full funding** from the **State Food Assistance Program** is restored in the State budget. The cut to State Food Assistance unjustly burdened immigrant families, primarily in communities of color, with hunger. Also passed were continued funding for food banks (EFAP), 9% restoration to TANF and continuation of the Farmers Market Nutrition Program, increasing family access to healthy, fresh food.

In addition to these nutrition programs, we are excited about the passing of the **Early Start Act**, which supports high-quality and culturally responsive care for children and much more. This is great news! For more information check out the [Children's Alliance](#) or [Food Lifeline](#) sites.
